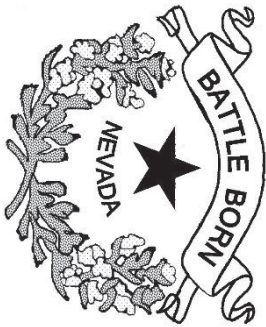

Nevada was admitted as a state on October 31, 1864 and is celebrating its sesquicentennial throughout 2014. The Greater Reno Stamp & Cover Show is excited to be a part of that celebration as an official Nevada 150 event. The souvenir show cover was designed by club member Harvey Edwards. The cachet on the cover depicts ranching, railroads, mining, and gaming, four industries that played an important role in Nevada’s early statehood and continue to be fundamental in Nevada’s economy today. The pictorial postmark, also designed by Harvey, incorporates artwork from the current Nevada state flag.

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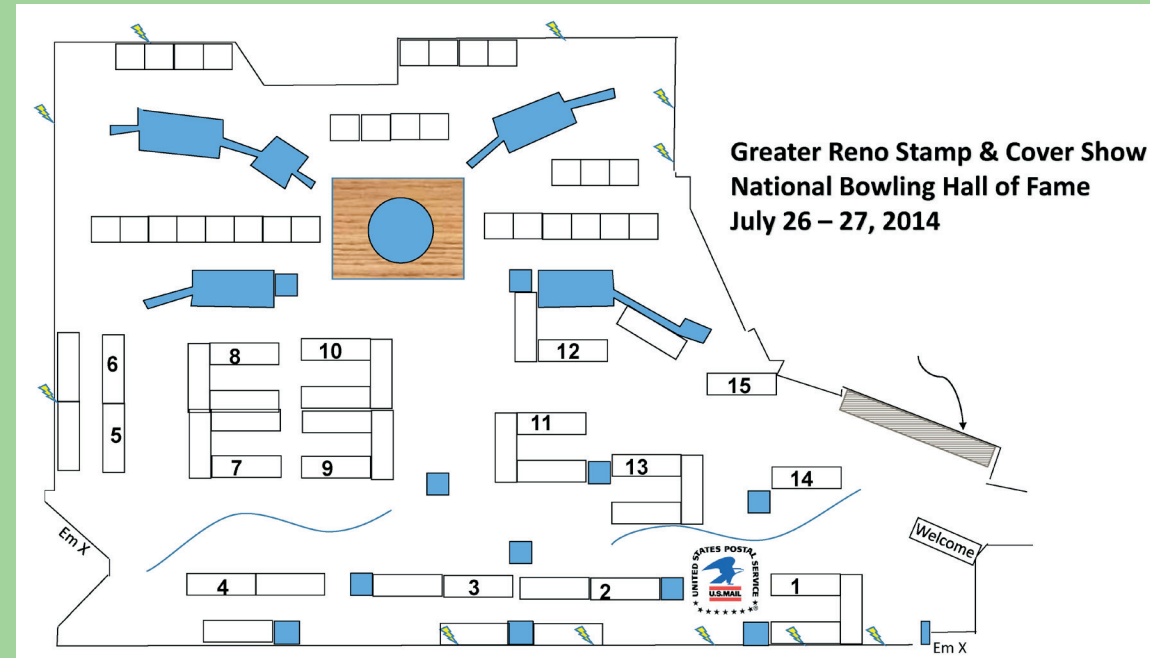
